This guide explains how to use the Appvibe Canva Integration for Jira app. It helps you manage Canva design links directly within Jira issues. With this app, you can add, edit, delete, and embed Canva designs effortlessly, providing easy access to relevant designs without leaving Jira.

Overview of Features

Key Features

1. **List Saved Canva Links**

- View all Canva links associated with a Jira issue in a clean, organized list.

2. **Add or Edit Links Inline**

- Use an **inline form** to quickly add or update links without leaving the issue page.

3. **Remove Links with a Confirmation Popup**

- Remove links easily with a **popup confirmation** to prevent accidental deletions.

4. **View Canva Designs Embedded in Jira**

- Click on a link to **embed the Canva design** directly inside the Jira issue using an **iframe**.

Getting Started

Installation

- **Log in to Jira**
 - Ensure you are logged in with **Admin privileges**.
- **Open the Atlassian Marketplace**
 - In Jira, click on **Apps** → **Explore more apps** to open the Marketplace.
- **Search for "Appvibe Canva Integration"**
 - Use the search bar to find the app.
- **Install the App**
 - Click **Get app** or **Try it free**.
 - Confirm the installation and grant the required permissions.
- **Configure the App**
 - Once installed, go to **Manage Apps** in the Admin section to ensure it's enabled.
 - The **Canva Integration** panel will now appear in your Jira issue view.
- **Start Using the App**
 - Open any Jira issue to view, add, or manage Canva links directly from the **Canva Integration** panel.

View Saved Canva Links

Click the **"Canva Integration"** button in the toolbar of a Jira issue (see image below). This opens the Canva section where you can manage your links.

In the **Canva Links section** (See image below), you'll see all saved links related to the current issue and be able to add a Canva embedded image.

Add/Edit/Remove a Canva Link

Add a Canva Link

Click the **"Add"** button (See image below). A form will appear inline, allowing you to enter:

- **Canva Design Embedded URL** – The link to your Canva design.
- **Title** – A meaningful name for the design. (optional)

NOTE: It is important to get the link in the right link. You will need a Canva smart embedded link. To do this, navigate to your Canva design, then go to Share > More > Embed > Smart embed link. Click on "Copy".

Once the details are entered, click **Add**.

Each saved link can be **Edited**:

- **Edit**: Opens the inline form for modifications.

Remove a Canva Link

Each saved link can be **Removed**:

- **Delete**: Triggers a **confirmation popup** for deletion.

Ensure the link is public and accessible. If Canva blocks embedding, try opening it in a new tab.

2. **Can I add multiple links to one issue?**

Yes, you can add multiple Canva links to each Jira issue.

3. **How secure are my Canva links?**

All links are stored within Jira's **Custom Entity Store** and are scoped to each issue, ensuring privacy and security.
