

Add a Canva Link

Click the **"Add"** button (See image below). A form will appear inline, allowing you to enter:

- **Canva Design Embedded URL** - The link to your Canva design.
- **Title** - A meaningful name for the design. (optional)

NOTE: It is important to get the link in the right link. You will need a Canva smart embedded link. To do this, navigate to your Canva design, then go to Share > More > Embed > Smart embed link. Click on "Copy".

Once the details are entered, click **Add**.
