Overview of Features

Key Features

Add Links:

Embed Google Forms links directly into Jira issues for quick access to spreadsheets. This feature allows users to easily associate relevant Google Forms documents with specific Jira tickets, enhancing workflow efficiency by bringing essential data closer to the project at hand.

Edit Links:

Update or modify embedded Google Forms links as the spreadsheet changes. With this capability, users can ensure that their Jira issues always point to the most current version of a form, facilitating up-to-date data sharing and project tracking.

Remove Links:

Remove links when they are no longer relevant. This feature ensures that outdated or unnecessary links don't clutter Jira issues, keeping them clean and focused on relevant information.

View Links in Preview and Full Screen:

Preview Google Forms content or expand it to full screen for a detailed view. This flexibility allows users to glance at Google Forms' content within Jira or delve deeper when more comprehensive access is needed without leaving the Jira environment.

Sort Links:

Organize Google Forms links by custom criteria, name, or date. This feature enhances the manageability of multiple links, allowing users to quickly find and access specific forms according to their preferred arrangement.

Realign Links:

Adjust the positioning of Google Forms links within the Jira issue. Users can reposition links to better align with the structure and flow of their Jira tickets, creating a more intuitive and user-friendly interface.

View Links in List or Tile View:

Toggle between list or tile layout for viewing links. This customizable view option provides users with flexibility in how they interact with linked forms, catering to different preferences and needs.

Manage Permissions:

Control who can view and interact with Google Forms links embedded in Jira. This feature ensures that sensitive data or internal documents can be shared securely and only accessed by authorized team members.

View Link History:

Access the history of changes made to each Google Forms link. By keeping track of alterations and updates across linked forms, users can maintain an audit trail for changes, enhancing accountability and collaboration.

Getting Started

Installation

Step 1:

Log in to Jira

Ensure you are logged in with Admin privileges.

Step 2:

Open the Atlassian Marketplace

In Jira, click on Apps → Explore more apps to open the Marketplace.

Search for **Appvibe Google Forms Integration**

Step 3:

Use the search bar to find the app.

Install the App

Click Get app or Try it free.

Confirm the installation and grant the required permissions.

Step 4:

Configure the App

Once installed, go to Manage Apps in the Admin section to ensure it's enabled.

The panel will now appear in your Jira issue view.

Step 5:

Start Using the App to add and view links for Google Forms

Open any Jira issue to view, add, or manage Google Forms links directly.

Working with Links

Add a Link

Step 1:

Inside a Jira issue, click the "Add" button. A form will appear inline, allowing you to enter your Embedded URL, which is the link to your Google Forms design, and an optional Title which is a meaningful name for the design.

Step 2:

Click the Add button again to add your Google Forms link to the Jira issue.

View a Link

Step 1:

Inside a Jira issue, locate the link you want to view and click the view icon associated with that link.

Step 2:

An inline popup will appear, displaying your Google Forms. You can also click for full screen viewing.

Edit a Link

Step 1:

Inside a Jira issue, find the link you want to edit and click "Edit" from the link dropdown.

Step 2:

A form will appear inline, allowing you to edit the following:

- **Embedded URL** – The link to your Google Forms design.
- **Title** – A meaningful name for the design. (optional)

Step 3:

Click the save button again to add your Google Forms link to the Jira issue.

Delete a Link

Step 1:

Inside a Jira issue, navigate to the linked Google Forms.

Step 2:

Click on the menu for the Google Forms link and select Delete.

Step 3:

You will be prompted to confirm if you want to delete this Google Forms link.

Advanced

View Link History

Step 1:

Begin by installing the Appvibe Google Forms Integration app in your Jira environment. This application is designed to seamlessly integrate Google Forms with Jira, allowing users to track modifications made to Google Forms links within any Jira issue.

Step 2:

Once installed, you can insert a Google Forms link into a Jira issue. Any modification to this link will be automatically tracked by the app. This tracking feature ensures that all changes to the Google Forms links are logged and stored in the history section.

Step 3:

Access the history of modifications at either the link level or the Jira issue level. This history is available for viewing at any time, providing users with a comprehensive log of all changes made to linked Google Forms within Jira issues, facilitating better collaboration and tracking of data inputs.

Link Permissions

Step 1:

Access the Appvibe Google Forms Integration configuration page or click on "permission" within the link settings in a Jira issue to manage link access.

Step 2:

Control and assign permissions to users for links in a Jira issue. Users can be assigned one of the following permissions:

- **Viewer:** Can see the link in the Jira issue.
- **Editor:** Can add, edit, or remove links in the Jira issue.
- **Admin:** Can manage link permissions for other users.

Select the desired permissions for each user as needed. Note that link permissions are managed at a system level.

FAQ

What if the Google Forms link doesn't load?

Ensure the link is public and accessible. If Google Forms blocks embedding, try opening it in a new tab.

Can I add multiple links to one issue?

Yes, you can add multiple Google Forms links to each Jira issue.

How secure are my Google Forms links?

All links and related metadata are stored within Atlassian's Forge platform. Our app data is stored using Forge's hosted storage solutions, which are integrated into Atlassian's cloud infrastructure. This setup ensures that app data benefits from the same data residency features as Atlassian's core products, allowing administrators to control where the data is hosted.
